1. GENERAL

- <u>Description:</u> Miniature Sheet (90X190mm) which contains four (4) Gummed Personalised Stamps perforated, dimensions 42X52mm each, for mailing tourist postcards (PostCards Worldwide), today one (1) euro. It depicts pictures of the Ionian Islands, Cyclades, Dodecanese and Crete. The stamps have QRC Code and by scanning it, a video is available which travels Greek beauties to all over the world.
- **Quantity:** One hundred fifty thousand (150.000)
- **Price:** The Miniature Sheet will be available for **four euros (4,00 €)**

4. COMMEMORATIVE POSTMARK

The Special Commemorative Postmark will be used on **Thursday 7 July 2022** at the **Athens Central Post Office, 100 Eolou St., 10564 Athens, from 09.00 a.m. to 13.00 p.m.**.



The Special Commemorative Postmark will also be available on three (3) consecutives Thursdays from the release date at the **Athens Central Post Office**, **100 Eolou St.**, **10564 Athens**, from **09.00 a.m. to 13.00 p.m.**.

Stamps of at least the minimum value of B' priority domestic mail, today **€0.90** must be affixed to each item to be postmarked. Any item to be posted must bear stamp(s) of the appropriate value for domestic or international mail or special delivery service, as the case may be.

Alternatively, collectors can send postal items free of charge to the Philatelic Service (100 Eolou St., 2nd floor, 10188 Athens), provided stamps to the value of at least the minimum value of B' priority domestic mail, today €0.90 have been affixed to them. Postal items to be stamped with the Commemorative Postmark will be accepted for a period of 60 days from the release of the postmark (the postmark stamped by the post office from which the item is sent indicates the date of posting). Philatelic items to be postmarked must bear the name and full address of the sender so that they can be sent to them. Please mark the envelope "PHILATELIC ITEMS".

At the end of the year, Hellenic Post will release a set of envelopes stamped with commemorative postmarks especially for commemorative postmark collectors. Each envelope will have the minimum value of B' priority domestic mail, today ≤ 0.90 stamp affixed to it and will be stamped with one of the special commemorative postmarks for 2022.
